DELFF/DALFF All Public

What is DELFF/DALFF All Public?

- Official diplomas issued by the French Ministry of National Education
- Levels: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 and C2
- Valid for life

Why taking the DELFF/DALFF All Public?

- To accomplish your projects in the high education context
> *French-speaking sections, scholarships (BGF, Eiffel, Polytechnique...)*
- To integrate exchange programs
> *Double diplomas, Civic Volunteering & International Programs...*
- To get a job in the Cambodian or international labor market
> *up to a 30% higher salary for French speakers!*



Who can pass the DELFF/DALFF All Public?

- Foreign people
- French people from a non-French-speaking country and non-holders of a French secondary or higher public education diploma

HOW TO PREPARE?

DELFF Prim'

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PRIM

What is DELFF Prim'?

- Official diplomas issued by the French Ministry of National Education
- Only for children aged between 7 & 11: enjoyable supports, themes specific to childhood
- Levels: A1.1, A1, A2
- Valid for life

Why taking the DELFF Prim'?

- To officially validate for life your child's first learning in French
- To promote your child's new French-language skills
- To train your child and build his/her confidence towards future language exams

DELFF Junior

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JUNIOR

What is DELFF Junior?

- Official diplomas issued by the French Ministry of National Education
- Reserved and suitable for teenagers between 12 and 17 years old
- Levels: A1, A2, B1, B2
- Valid for life

Why taking the DELFF Junior?

- To pursue studies in a French-speaking university, in a large school
- To promote your child's new French-language skills
- To train your child and build his/her confidence towards future language exams

TCF

French Language Knowledge Exam

Unlike the DELF/DALF - which assigns an overall level - the TCF **assess**s an overall level AND a level per skill. It is valid for two years, thus offering a recent image of your level in French.

ACCORDING TO YOUR GOALS, SEVERAL VERSIONS OF THE TCF ARE AVAILABLE:

- TCF All Public
- TCF for Access to French Nationality
- TCF Quebec
- TCF Canada

TCF All Public

What is TCF All Public?

- Exam assessing general French skills from A1 to C2
- Valid for 2 years
- 30 days delay between two exams

Why taking the TCF All Public?

- To assess your knowledge in French
- To promote your skills in the professional world
- To integrate higher education

Who can take the TCF?

- Teenagers (from 16 years old) and adults whom French is not the mother tongue.

What's the form of the exam?

- **3 mandatory exams** (76 questions - 1 h 25):
 - > **Oral comprehension** 29 questions / 25 minutes
 - > **Mastering the language structures** 18 questions / 15 minutes
 - > **Written comprehension** 29 questions / 45 minutes
- **2 additional exams:**
 - > **Oral expression** 12 minutes
 - > **Written expression** 60 minutes

TCF for Access to French Nationality (ANF)

What is the TCF ANF?

- Exam assessing the French-language skills of applicants for the acquisition of the French nationality
- Valid for 2 years

Why taking the TCF ANF?

- For an application for the French nationality

Who can take the TCF ANF?

- Candidates for French nationality

Cases of exemptions on ciep.fr/tcf-anf

What's the form of the exam?

• 4 mandatory tests:

- > **Oral comprehension**
29 questions / 25 minutes
- > **Written comprehension**
29 questions / 45 minutes
- > **Written expression**
3 tasks / 30 minutes
- > **Oral expression**
3 tasks / 10 minutes

TCF Quebec

What is the TCF Quebec?

- Exam assessing the French-language skills of applicants for Quebec immigration
- Valid for 2 years

Why taking the TCF Quebec?

- For Quebec immigration application

Who can take the TCF Quebec?

- Anyone wishing to immigrate in Quebec

Possible exemptions TCF TP, DELF,
DALF: ciep.fr/tcf-quebec

What's the form of the exam?

• 1 to 4 exams:

- > **Oral comprehension**
29 questions / 25 minutes
- > **Written comprehension**
29 questions / 45 minutes
- > **Oral expression**
3 tasks / 12 minutes
- > **Written expression**
3 tasks / 60 minutes

- Since 2013, level B2 is mandatory to get the total of 16 points for this language assessment.

TCF Canada

What is TCF Canada?

- Exam assessing the French-language skills of applicants for Canada immigration
- Valid for 2 years

Why taking the TCF Canada?

- For an economic immigration application or the obtention of Canadian citizenship with Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC)

Who can take the TCF Canada?

- Anyone wishing to immigrate to Canada
- No possible exemption

What's the form of the exam?

• 4 mandatory exams:

- > **Oral comprehension**
39 questions / 35 minutes
- > **Written comprehension**
39 questions / 60 minutes
- > **Oral expression**
3 tasks / 12 minutes
- > **Written expression**
3 tasks / 60 minutes

- The levels required for immigration to Canada are specified on ciep.fr/tcf-canada

2/ Holder of a FLE teaching degree with significant experience of more than two years in teaching

3/ Significant experience of more than three years in FLE teaching

STEP 2

Apply to the Institut français du Cambodge at direction.cdl@institutfrancais-cambodge.com.

STEP 3

The Institut français du Cambodge sends the application file

STEP 4

Fill the application form, and attach the requested documents
